



## **Special Press Release**

**Date: 09-05-2016**

**Sub: Weather over Uttarakhand from 9<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2016**

A trough from Punjab to Northwest Bay of Bengal in lower levels with embedded cyclonic circulations over Punjab and neighbourhood likely to prevail during 9<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2016. A Western Disturbance (WD) also likely to move across Afghanistan, North Pakistan and Northern parts of Jammu & Kashmir during 10<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> May.

### **Expected Weather:**

#### **(A) Rainfall:**

Under the influence of above systems, scattered to fairly widespread light to moderate thunderstorm activities are expected and leading to:

- (i) Light to moderate rainfall at many places from 10<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> May and,
- (ii) Very light to light rainfall at a few places on 9<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> May with moderate rainfall at isolated places in Uttarakhand.

#### **(B) Temperatures:**

The maximum temperatures are likely to remain near normal or below normal over the State on most of the days during the week.

### **Warning:**

**Heavy rainfall likely to occur at isolated places in Uttarakhand especially in Uttarkashi, Chamoli, Rudraprayag, Tehri Garhwal and Dehradun districts during next 72 hours from morning of 10<sup>th</sup> May, 2016.**
