Subject: Weather Over Uttarakhand From 3rd to 6th May, 2016.

Western Disturbances and an east-west trough from Punjab to Northwest Bay of Bengal in lower levels with embedded cyclonic circulations one over Punjab and neighbourhood and another over southeast Uttar Pradesh & neighbourhood are likely to affect northwest India including **Uttarakhand** mainly from 3rd May to 6th May 2016.

Expected Weather:

- a. Under present dry weather conditions, day temperatures are likely to increase by about 2 degree Celsius during next 2-3 days upto 2nd May and will fall significantly thereafter.
- b. Under the influence of above weather systems, fairly widespread light to moderate thunderstorm activities are expected and leading to:
 - (i) Light to moderate rainfall at many places on 4th, 5th and 6th May and,
 - (ii) Very light to light rainfall at a few places with moderate rainfall at isolated places on 3rd May in Uttarakhand.

Warnings:

- (i) Thunder squall speed reaching 50-60 KMPH likely at isolated places in Uttarakhand on 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th May.
- (ii) Hailstorm also likely at isolated places on 5th and 6th May especially in plains of Uttarakhand.

Advisory:

- (i) Farmers are advised to take necessary measures to harvest the ripe crops and store in safe places before 3rd May.
- (ii) The water management authorities are advised to take necessary measures to use rainwater.
