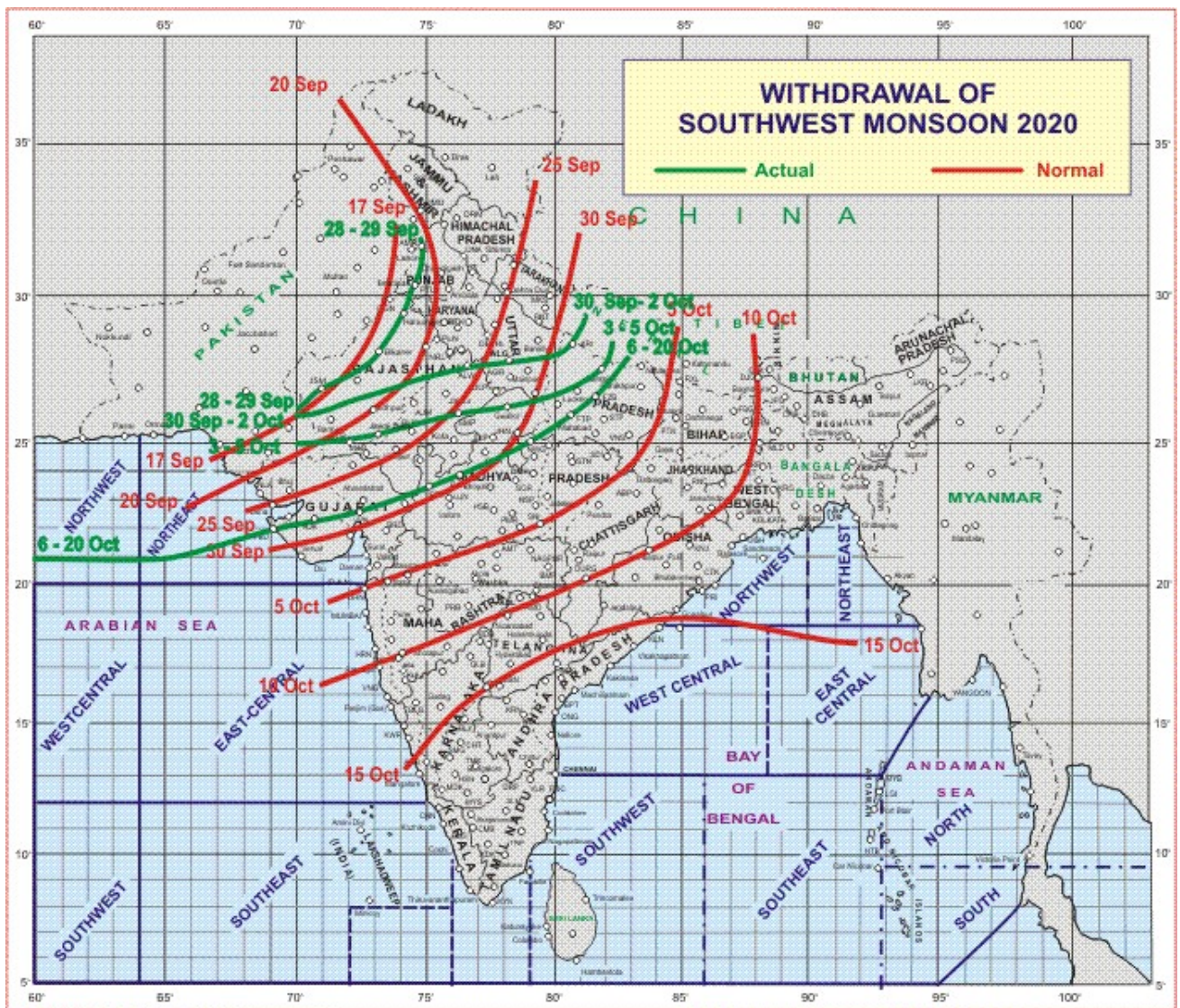

Monsoon Watch

The withdrawal line of the Southwest Monsoon continues to pass through Lat. 28°N/Long.83°E, Faizabad, Fatehpur, Nowgong, Rajgarh, Ratlam, Vallabh Vidyanagar, Porbandar, Lat. 21°N/ Long.65°E and Lat.21°N/ Long.60°E. Conditions are becoming favorable for further withdrawal of south-west monsoon from remaining parts of Uttar Pradesh during next 2-3 days.
