SUMMARY OF OBSERVATIONS RECORDED AT 0830 HOURS IST:

RAINFALL:

Rain/thundershowers occurred at most places over Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand and west Uttar Pradesh, at many places over Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit-Baltistan and Muzaffarabad and east Uttar Pradesh, at a few places over Haryana and Delhi and at isolated places over Punjab and Rajasthan.

Himachal Pradesh: Sangla7,Reckong Peo and Kalpa 5 each .

MAXIMUM TEMPERATURES:

Maximum temperatures has no large change over Punjab and West Rajasthan, appreciable fell in Himachal Pradesh, east Uttar Pradesh and East Rajasthan and markedly fell over rest of the region. They were appreciably below normal in Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit, Baltistan ,Muzaffarabad, Punjab,

below normal in west Rajasthan , normal over east Uttar Pradesh and markedly below normal over rest of the region. The highest maximum temperature in the region was **37.7°C** recorded at **Barmer (Rajasthan)**.

MINIMUM TEMPERATURES: Minimum temperatures appreciably fell over Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Gilgit, Baltistan ,Muzaffarabad and Himachal Pradesh and has no large change over rest of the region. They were appreciably above normal Punjab and east Uttar Pradesh,normal over Himachal Pradesh and above normal over rest of the region. The lowest minimum temperature over the plains of northwest India was **16.3°C** recorded at **Gurudaspur (Punjab)**.

FORECAST VALID FOR NEXT 05 DAYS:

No significant change in maximum and minimum temperatures over the Northwest India.
